A man in a Kansas prison asked to be transferred after two of his cellmates tested positive for COVID-19. The prison declined, and now he's sick.

#### Here's what you should know

Michelle Orton, an educator in Wichita, said her son, a prisoner at the Lansing Correctional Facility in eastern Kansas, asked to be moved after two of his cellmates tested positive for COVID-19 on July 11.

His request was not granted, she said, and 11 days later he tested positive for the virus.

More than two years into the pandemic, the state hasn't done enough to protect her son from COVID-19, Orton said Monday.

"They're not doing anything for me, Mom," he told her.

He doesn't have any underlying conditions that would physically make COVID more dangerous for him, his mother said, adding that her son has other mental health struggles that are worsened by having to stay in his cell for longer stretches of time due to his COVID infection.

#### Kansas City area hospital takes the top spot for 13th year

The University of Kansas Hospital is the No. 1 hospital in the Kansas City metro for the 13th year in a row, according to the annual U.S. News & World Report Best Hospitals ranking released Tuesday.

KU was also named the best hospital in Kansas for the 11th consecutive year. No other hospital has ever received these honors. The hospital is also nationally ranked among the country's top 50 hospitals in eight specialties.

Saint Luke's was named the second-best hospital in Missouri behind Barnes-Jewish Hospital in St. Louis. North Kansas City Hospital and Saint Luke's East tied for No. 8 in Missouri.
