What we found

There is overwhelming evidence to suggest that articles with embedded multimedia elements are associated with higher paths.



Why Multimedia?



Statistical Modeling

Statistical modeling is a method using **historical data to approximate reality** and making predictions based on that approximation.

Here, we use it to mathematically describe how paths change when embedded multimedia elements change.



Training process

The model learns from our historical article data to draw empirical relationships. This is known as "training"

- Given an article has some kind of multimedia, how many paths do we expect it to get?
- Extrapolate the effect of having multimedia elements for stories in different sections.
- Control for subscription offers and the section the story is in.

Statistical significance

If an effect is statistically <mark>significant</mark>, we can conclude that the effect we observe is real, not due to chance.

A statistically insignificant effect simply tells us that we don't have enough evidence to make this conclusion.

This does not mean a relationship does not exist, but that we are not confident in the relationship given the number of samples we have and the size of the effect in the sample.

We expect paths to increase as number of images increase

We expect articles with more images to get more paths.

This relationship starts plateauing with more images added.

At some point, the number of images has diminishing returns.



The model extrapolated these patterns from the data:


Articles with more images have more paths on average.

Body Images Counts by Section



Because of limited stories with video, there is not a lot of certainty in the relationship between video and paths.





The same trend follows for stories with galleries.


